Y11 TO Y12 BRIDGING TASKS

The following tasks are designed to help you to prepare for the CAM TECH level 3 course in Performing Arts. You may find some of them quite challenging as this may be the first time you have completed work at this level. You will be expected to hand in/present the work to your teacher during the first lesson.

Task 1 – Unit 1 – Prepare to work in the Performing Arts Sector:

Prepare a presentation to introduce yourself to the rest of the class. Your presentation should last approximately five minutes and be designed to introduce yourself as a performing arts practitioner at the start of your career so you should include information about your experiences so far in the performing arts industry and your aspirations for your future career in the performing arts. Your presentation should include the following points:

- (a) Why have you applied for this course?
- (b) What role / discipline you are most interested in (acting, dancing, singing etc), and how will this contribute to the performances you participate in whilst on the course?
- (c) What skills and experience do you have so far in the performing arts? (school shows, youth theatre, dance / singing lessons etc)
- (d) What is your progression strategy for the next five years? (Where would you like to be in your career five years from now?)
- (e) What do you hope to gain from this course and how do you think this course will contribute to your progression route / future career?

Task 2 – Unit 1 – Prepare to work in the Performing Arts Sector:

Prepare a short performance (2-4 minutes) to showcase your talents. This could be in the discipline of acting, singing or dance; or a combination of performance disciplines. It could be a piece you have devised yourself or an extract from an existing piece of repertoire.
